

# 3RTV Cable TV

## Quick Reference Guide

### ***Input Buttons***

*(your remote may be slightly different but same process applies)*

- AUX (Auxiliary)
- DVD (DVD Player)
- AUD (Audio)
- TV
- STB (Set Top Box)



The device selection buttons tell your remote control whether you want to control your set top box or your television. Auxiliary, DVD and Audio buttons can be used to control these devices if you choose, provided the remote is programmed correctly.

*Note: Your remote control must have the remote code programmed in before it can send the correct signals for your TV or other devices. A list is available at [www.3rivers.net/video/3rtv](http://www.3rivers.net/video/3rtv). Contact a 3 Rivers customer service representative or your device manufacturer if you need more information.*

To turn your TV on or off, press the TV button then the POWER button.

To turn your Set Top Box on or off, press the STB button and then the Power button.

**If pressing Power turned the wrong device on or off, press the Power button again, press the appropriate device selection button (AUX, AUD, DVD, TV or STB) and press Power once more.**

### ***DVR (Digital Video Recorder)***

The fastest and easiest way to begin recording is to use the RECORD button on your remote control. While watching a program, simply press Record. Recording will begin immediately.

You can also start a quick record while in the Guide screen.

1. Highlight a program you want to record using the Arrow Keys and press Record.
2. If the program is currently on, recording will begin immediately.
3. If the program comes on in the future, your system will record the program for you automatically. Even if your TV is turned off the recording will take place.
